
## Dr. Jitendra Singh refers to functioning of Central Administrative Tribunal

inaugurated the Administrative Block of the Central Administrative Tribunal, Principal Bench, New Delhi today in the august presence of Hon'ble Mr. Justice L. Narasimha Reddy, Chairman, CAT.
