

This first appeal has been filed against the reply dated 23.04.2018 given by the CPIO (J) to the appellant herein, against the application dated 31.03.2018, received on transfer from the CIC vide their communication dated 19.04.2018. A perusal of the records shows that the appellant vide his application dated 31.03.2018 asked for a copy of the order dated 02.01.2012 passed in OA No. 1151/2000 by the Central Administrative Tribunal, PB, New Delhi. Copy of the order available in case file number asked for had been sent to the appellant, though the date of order was different. Now, vide his appeal in hand the appellant as asked for copy of the order dated 02.01.2012 in OA No. 1151/2012. I have called for records of OA No. 1151/2012. It is noticed that the final order available in the said case is dated 10.04.2012, whereas the appellant has asked for a copy of the order dated 02.01.2012.



Obviously, the appellant himself is not sure as to what exactly he wants. Until or unless he furnishes correct particulars, information asked for cannot be supplied by the CPIO. It is also pertinent to point out that in his application to the CPIO, the appellant had asked a copy of the order dated 02.01.2012 passed in OA No. 1151/2000 and now he has asked for a copy of the order dated 02.01.2012 in OA No. 1151/2012. Legally, the appellant cannot raise the new issue in an appeal. He can only ask for and raise the issue, which was subject matter of his application before the CPIO.

In view of the above the appeal in hand is dismissed.

In case the appellant is not satisfied with this decision, he may file second appeal before the Second Appellate Authority i.e. Central Information Commission, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, B Wing, August Kranti Bhavan, Bhikaji Cama Place, New Delhi – 110066.
