Facts:

This First Appeal dated 13.08.2019 has been received against the reply of the CPIO (JA), dated 30.07.2018. I have gone through the RTI application dated 05th July 2019 and the reply of the CPIO thereto. From the perusal of the RTI application, it is observed that the Appellant herein has sought the information which is not in the custody of the Public Authority. The relief in the case allowing/dismissing the same depends upon the circumstances/facts and relevant Law. Needless to say that a judgment is not a single page order of few lines, the judgment contains the summary of arguments of both the parties, law of the land, previous judgment on the issue, conclusion and the reason for arriving on that conclusion. Judges need time.

Moreover, as per the Law, Practice and Procedure of the RTI, the applicant or the appellant cannot force the CPIO or the First Appellate Authority for disclose the information acknowledgedly don't hold.

In view of the above facts and circumstances no information can be furnished.

This Appeal is thus disposed of.

In case you are not satisfied with this decision, you may file second appeal before the Second Appellate Authority, i.e., Central Information Commission, Baba Gang Nath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-67.
